

MVP Coverage

A MVP Representative writes...

We have a breadth of direct bill options with Part D coverage – from \$0 premium, which still has comprehensive benefits and Silver Sneakers, but higher co-payments, to slighter higher premium options that have lower co-payments. We also have products with out of network coverage for those who spend part of the year out of the area. We're exploring other options for the Kodak retirees, as well, but some of that may require regulatory approval, so it will take some time to see if those options will be allowed. Bottom line, if Kodak ends up changing its retirees' health benefits, we will do everything possible to provide those retirees with a broad range of attractive, affordable direct bill options.

Now that Kodak has filed for Chapter 11, there will be a very specific legal process that has to be followed, so we don't anticipate anything too sudden happening with retiree benefits. It is my hope and belief that retirees will have plenty of time to evaluate their options, when and if the day comes. I should note that if some of your EK friends are outside our service area, they will ultimately have to find other coverage options specific to the counties and states where they live, if Kodak discontinues retiree health benefits. We've looked at the options available to all the locales across the country where there are more than 100 Kodak retirees and almost all of them have pretty good options. I wish we could offer something to help the out of area retirees, but we don't have direct bill plans outside of New York.

We're hosting a number of informational meetings next week, if you want to share that information with your friends, as well. I've attached the dates, times and locations.

MVP HEALTH CARE ANNOUNCES INFORMATIONAL MEETINGS FOR KODAK MEDICARE-ELIGIBLE RETIREES TO DISCUSS MEDICARE COVERAGE OPTIONS

MVP set to offer affordable plan options to Rochester-based Medicare- eligible retirees and spouses; Avoids any potential lapse in MVP's top-ranked Medicare coverage

(Rochester, NY) Responding to numerous inquiries, MVP Health Care has scheduled a series of informational meetings in February in the Rochester area to help Medicare-eligible Kodak retirees and their Medicare-eligible dependents better understand their current coverage and how they might maintain similar coverage if they were to need to convert to a suitable individual plan.

“Kodak continues as our customer and we continue to meet the health care needs of Kodak’s employees and retirees,” said David W. Oliker, MVP President and Chief Executive Officer.

To address the specific concerns of Medicare-eligible Kodak retirees, MVP will hold informational meetings to help them better understand the other health insurance options available should there be significant changes to their coverage in the future.

Meetings will be held on the following dates at these locations:

- February 2, Burgundy Basin Inn, 1361 Marsh Road, Pittsford. Sessions will be at 9am, 11am, 1pm and 3pm.
- February 3rd at Rochester Airport Marriott, 1890 West Ridge Rd., Greece. Sessions will be at 9am, 11am, 1pm and 3pm.
- February 6th at Holiday Inn Airport, 911 Brooks Ave., Rochester. Sessions will be at 9am, 11am, 1pm and 3pm.

“We are prepared to enroll all Medicare-eligible Kodak retirees in the Greater Rochester area and their Medicare-eligible dependents into MVP’s GoldValue HMO-POS plan that most resembles their current coverage, including prescription drugs,” said Lisa Brubaker, MVP Executive Vice President for the Rochester Region and Government Programs. “This means they will be able to continue to have affordable coverage with an MVP Medicare Advantage plan that is top-ranked in New York State.”

MVP does not offer Medicare Advantage plans to individuals who reside outside its coverage area. MVP will provide information directly to these retirees to help them identify potential coverage in their areas. Or, these retirees can obtain more information at www.medicare.gov.

For all current Kodak Medicare-eligible retirees residing inside its coverage area, each MVP Medicare Advantage plan will be available to them regardless of health status or pre-existing conditions.
