Lewis L. "Abe" Lincoln died in Webster 2/26/15 at age 88, survived by his wife Mary, six children and 11 grandkids. He had earned a BS in Chemistry from the University of Rochester and worked in Emulsion Research Division's Sensitizing Dye Synthesis Lab under Don Heseltine for many years as a Senior Staff member. By 1983 he was in the Emulsion Chemistry Lab under Wolfgang Gunther and by 1985 was in the Photographic Materials Research Lab.

Dolf Bass remembers looking out his B83 office window one noon and noting that a car had been rear-ended at the corner of Eastman and Lake Ave. Abe came to the back of his car to inspect the damage, and the addled driver behind him ran into his leg. He limped a little thereafter but was always smiling. A good man, Dolf declares.
